NEW SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES IN DECEMBER



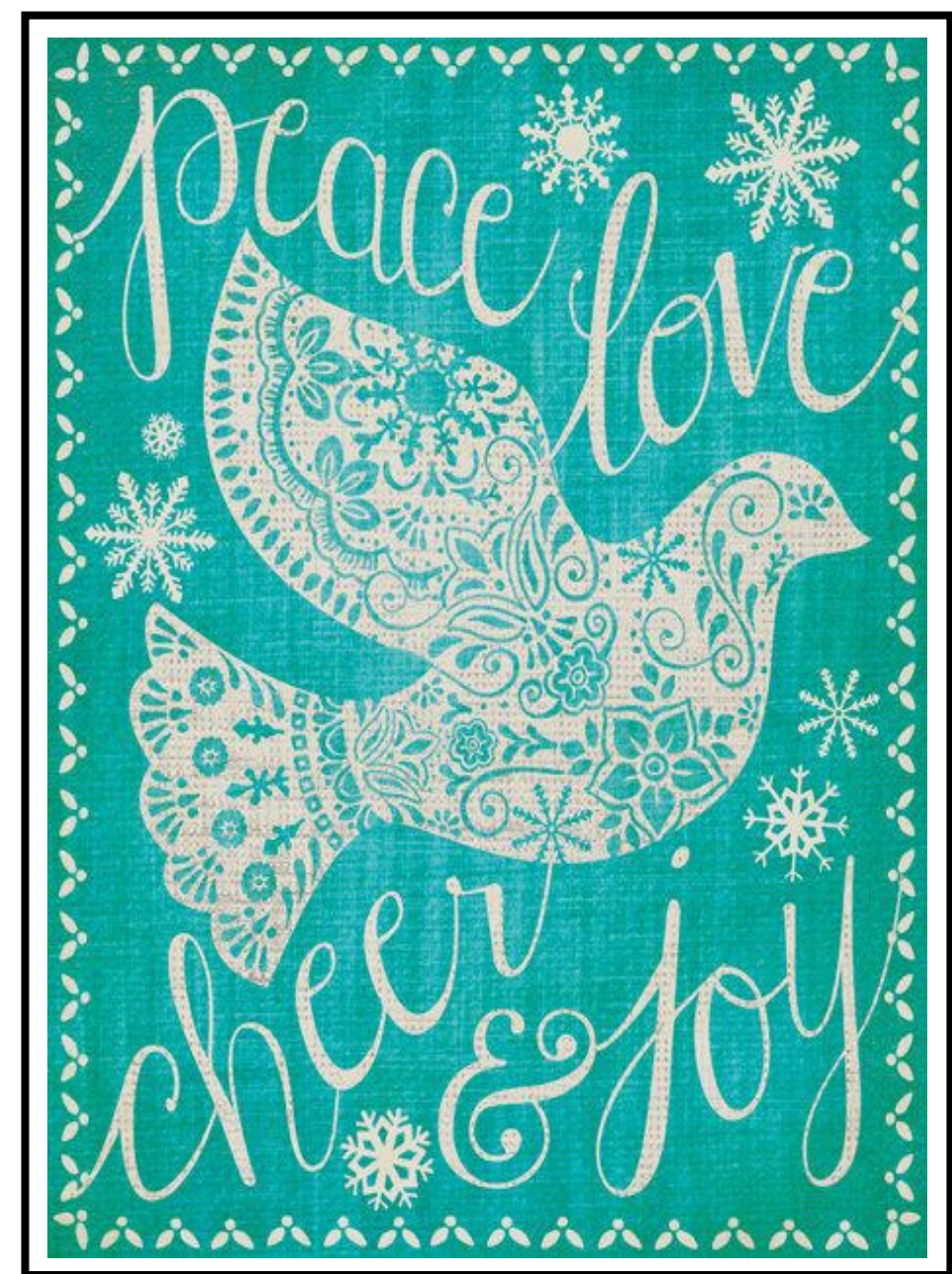
12/3/17 – Missionary during S.S. – Jr. High, Sr. High and Adults in Auditorium for combined class
