Items up for Discussion/Vote:

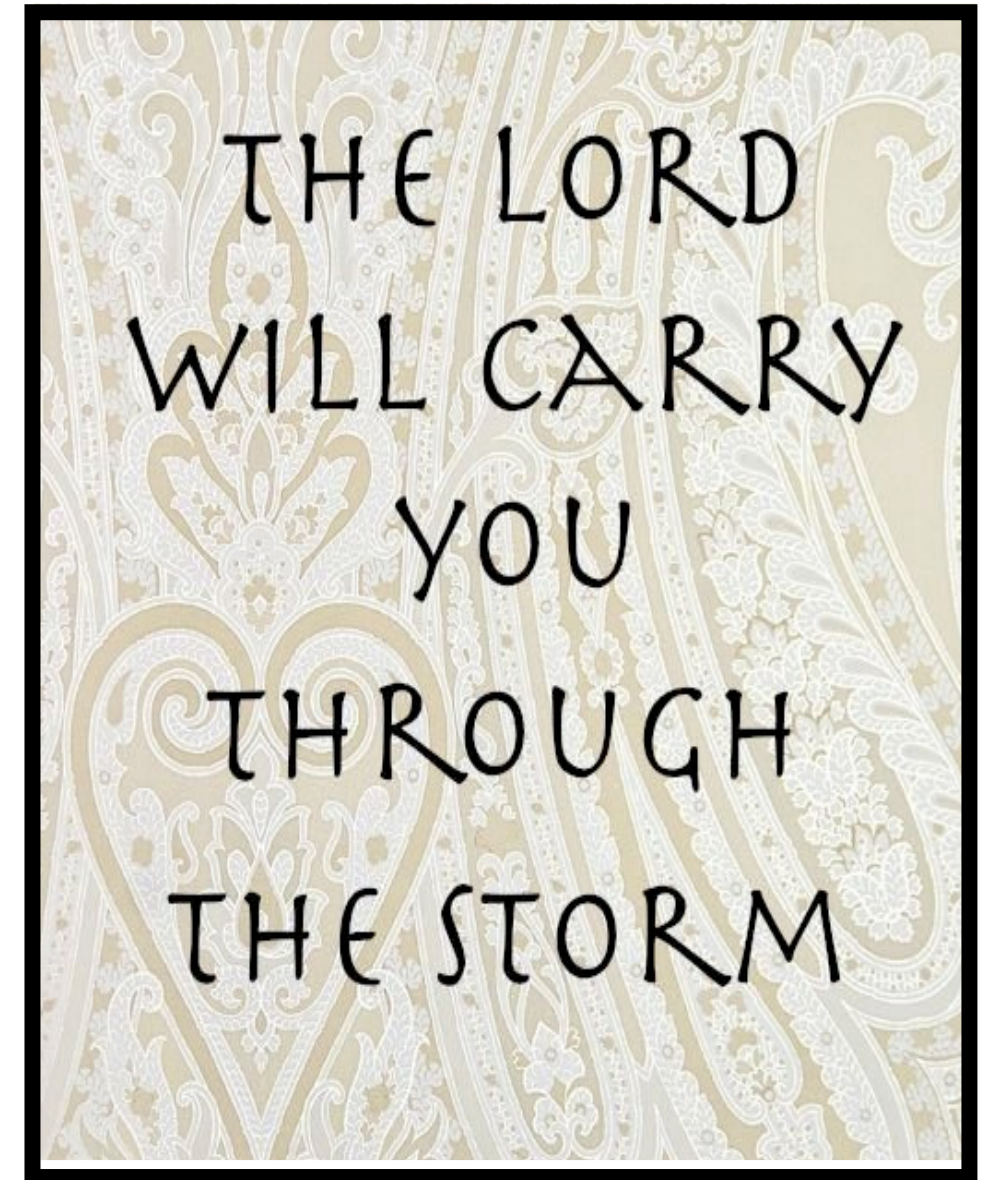
1. The deacon and elder boards recommend a 3% pay increase for the church secretary Sara Martin (from \$12.98 per hour to \$13.37 per hour).
