3. Discussion, Vote & Approval for 2018-2019 budget.

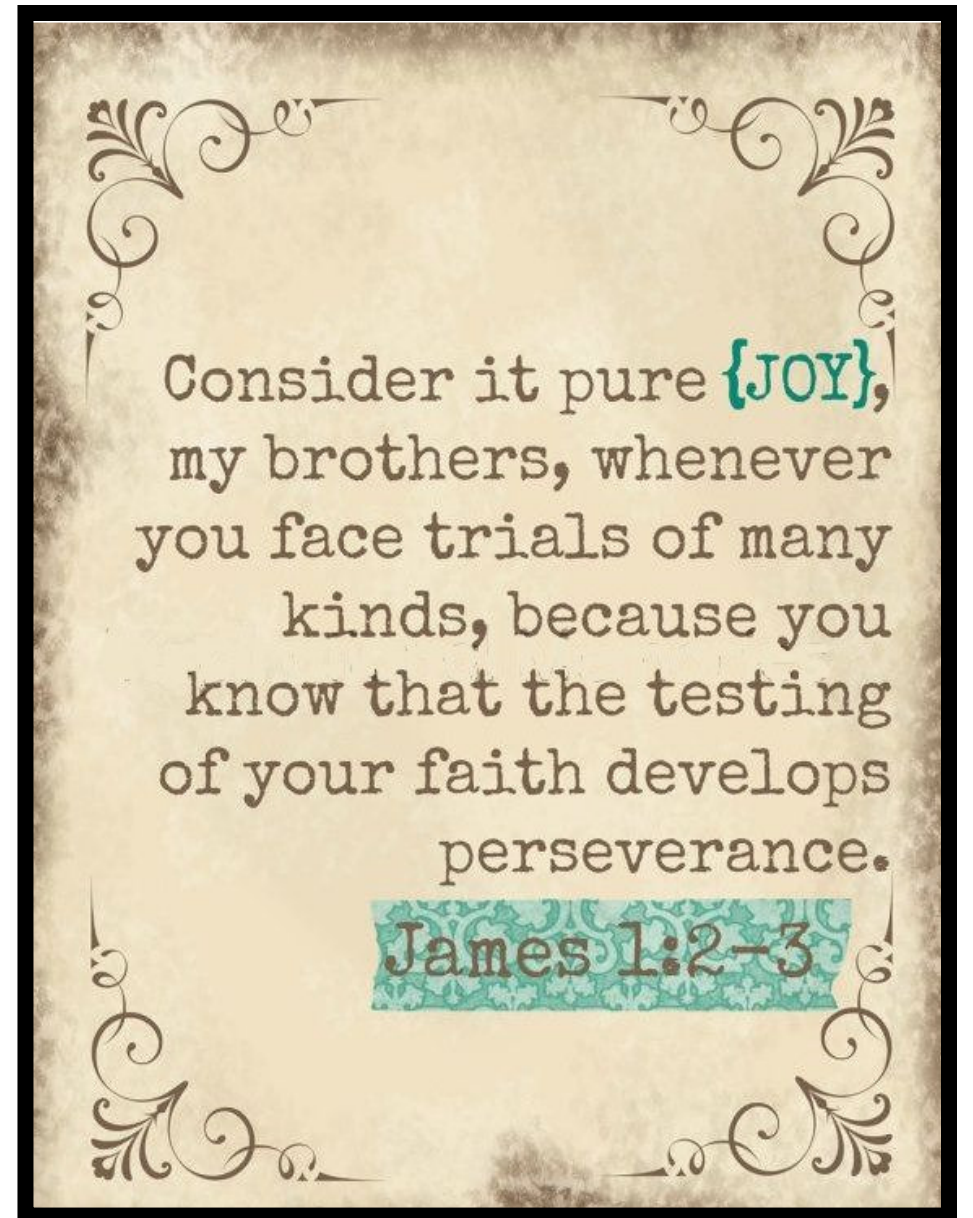
